The Japanese practice, which has just celebrated its 60 anniversary, continues to work primarily in its home market and in China. In 2018, it hopes to expand its work in the ASEAN region, which consists of 10 South-east Asian states.

Showa Sekkei operates in most of the main market sectors, with a particular recent specialism in large-scale distribution centres. Current significant projects include a 10,000sq m nursing home in Beijing, China and a headquarters for a car design company in Japan, which is due to complete in 2018.

## 95 SARAIVA + ASSOCIADOS

The Portuguese practice enters the rankings for the first time after increasing its architect numbers by 23. Established in Lisbon in 1996 by Miguel Saraiva, Saraiva + Associados has offices in 13 countries including Algeria, Brazil, China, Equatorial Guinea and most recently, Lausanne in Switzerland.

The practice's diverse workload encompasses schools, hotels, housing, retail and healthcare. Saraiva + Associados has a sustainability division - S + A Green Lab - and was the architect of the first BREEAM-certified office building in Portugal. Buildings under construction include the Cité du Millenium multi-use complex in Algeria, the Savoy Palace hotel and resort in Madeira and the White Shell residential complex on the Algarve in Portugal.

South African practice Boogertman + Partners moves into the rankings for the first time. Established in 1982, the multidisciplinary architecture and design practice has five offices across South Africa and Kenya. Placed second for workload in Africa, projects include the New Sight Eye Clinic in Ouesso, Congo (in collaboration with Geyser Hahn Architects), the Knightsbridge Office Park in Johannesburg and the Kumasi City Mall in Ghana, which was voted Best Retail Development at the Africa Property Investment Summit.

Looking to the future, Boogertman + Partners is eyeing expansion into the UK and Australian markets.



## 97 SCHMIDT HAMMER LASSEN

The Danish practice returns to the Top 100 rankings as it pursues a more global and diverse workload with particular success in the cultural and mixed-use sectors. It currently has more than 20 projects on site including a number of large-scale projects in China, among them the 115,000sq m Shanghai East Library.

In addition to China and the practice's core markets of Scandinavia and mainland Europe, Schmidt Hammer Lassen also expects a particular focus in North America in 2018, where work includes its first US project, the Monroe Blocks mixed-use development in downtown Detroit.

The practice also has projects underway in Australia and New Zealand.

## 98 RICHEZ ASSOCIÉS

Based in Paris and Kuala Lumpur, this French practice is anticipating a "great" year in 2018 with the start on site of a number of major projects, including three stations for the new Grand Paris Express network of rapid transit lines. Richez is also working on a redevelopment masterplan for La Défense in Paris and is involved in the major regeneration of Ardoines just outside the capital in Vitry-sur-Seine.

While France and China are its main markets, Richez is expanding its transportation work into Australia and is already active in Africa, where it is designing a new central market at Bouaké in the Ivory Coast.
